ABOUT THE GRANT

The IMU-CDC Abel Visiting Scholar Program is fully funded by the Abel Prize in mathematics. It is designed for post doctoral mathematicians under the age of 35 in the early stages of their professional careers and based in a developing country by offering them the opportunity of a month long research sabbatical at an internationally renowned mathematical center of excellence.

Selected applicants will be granted up to 5,000 USD to cover their expenses during their month-long research visit.

APPLICATION DEADLINE
