ABOUT THE GRANT

The IMU-Simons African Fellowship Program funded by the Simons Foundation, New York City, USA, supports research sabbaticals for mathematicians from African developing countries employed in Africa to travel to an internationally known mathematical center of excellence (worldwide) for collaborative research.

Selected applicants will be granted up to 5,000 USD to cover their travel and living expenses during their research visit for a duration of at least one month. There is no limit on the duration of the visit but please note that this is not intended for post graduate courses or post doctoral trainings!

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications run four times each year with deadlines in January, April, July, and October. Kindly visit the website for exact dates.
