# MARYAM MIRZAKHANI

Born and raised in Iran, professor of Mathematics at Stanford University, Maryam Mirzakhani (12.05.1977 – 15.07.2017) has been the first woman recipient of the Fields medal.

An initiative of the Committee for Women in Mathematics of the International Mathematical Union, Remember Maryam Mirzakhani is an exhibition with 18 original posters first opened at (WM)<sup>2</sup>, the World Meeting for Women in Mathematics, during ICM 2018, the International

Congress of Mathematicians. Thais Jordao is the curator of the exhibition and Rafael Meireles Barroso its designer. Since then, more than 20 copies of the exhibition have been shown in a variety of countries including Brasil, Canada, France, Iran, Italy, Sweden, Spain, Turkey and the USA.

**Mathematics is universal. Maryam will always remind us that excellence in mathematics is not a matter of gender nor geography.**
