1. International Congress of Mathematicians, 1966

The next International Congress of Mathematicians will meet in Moscow during the third week of August 1966, at the invitation of the U.S.S.R. National Committee for Mathematics. Professor I. G. Petrovski is the President of the Organizing Committee, Professor C. N. Mergelyan Vice-President, and Dr. V. G. Karamanov Secretary.

2. Symposia, Colloquia, etc., 1963

IMU supported or co-sponsored the following meetings and research projects in 1963:

(i) Instructional Conference on Mathematical Probability, Durham (England),
 28 March — 11 April, 1963

The conference was co-sponsored by the lMU, the Royal Society, the London Mathematical Society, and the Royal Statistical Society and financially supported by IMU.

(ii) Italian Summer Research Centre, 1963

The Centre was jointly sponsored by IMU, N.A.T.O., the Italian National Research Council and the Italian Ministry of Public Instruction. There were three sessions: (a) Abstract Differential Equations, 30 May — 8 June; (b) Complex Functions and Manifolds, 25 June — 5 July; and (c) Comparison and Averaging Methods in Mathematical Physics, 30 June — 9 July.

(iii) Colloquium on Abelian Groups, Tihany (Hungary), 2—8 September, 1963
