

Call for nominations to ICMI EC Nominating Committee

Dear ICMI Country Representatives,
Cc to the IMU Adhering Organizations,

I hope this e-mail finds you well.

We hereby invite you to propose, in consultation with the IMU Adhering Organization of your country, one candidate to serve on the **Nominating Committee** for the ICMI Executive Committee (2029-2032).

The present ICMI Executive Committee (2025-2028) is now in its second year of office. According to ICMI's regulations, the process for the nomination of the next Executive Committee should start now, two years before the next ICMI General Assembly to be held in Prague, Czech Republic, on July 8, 2028, where the election of the new ICMI EC will take place. This election is based on the slate that the Nominating Committee will propose.

Therefore, the first step in the election process consists of the formation of a Nominating Committee, which includes altogether seven members, two of whom are chosen at random from a pool of nominees submitted by the ICMI member countries through the country representatives.

In proposing the candidate for the ICMI EC Nominating Committee, please bear in mind that:

- The candidates should be willing to actively serve on the Nominating Committee throughout the process.
- Candidates should not be current members of the present [ICMI EC](#) and, if selected, cannot be a candidate for the next ICMI EC.
- An ICMI country representative may be nominated for this position by the IMU Adhering Organization.

In addition to submitting the name of a candidate, please include the following information (maximum of 5 sentences):

- How the candidate was selected;
- Why this person may be an appropriate candidate for the Nominating Committee.

Submission of candidacies should be sent to the ICMI President email:

icmi.president@mathunion.org and cc to icmi.administrator@mathunion.org no later than **December 1, 2026**.

The members will be randomly selected from the whole pool of candidates submitted by the country representatives. However, it is a requirement that those selected by this process must not be working in the same country as the Nominating Committee Chair, the IMU President, the ICMI President, or the IMU's nominee to the NC. As the identity of some of the latter members is not yet announced, this requirement may invalidate some of your nominations.
